 - (1) For a student who is being awarded a baccalaureate degree and who has completed sixty or more credits at the

The gradepoint average will be rounded to the nearest hundredth for the purpose of determining graduation with honors.

A student who holds an associate degree from an accredited institution, including the university of Akron, and who earns a subsequent associate degree at the university of Akron per the academic policy requirements for second degrees, is eligible to graduate with honors.

- (3) Meet all degree requirements including grade point requirements which are in force at the time a transfer is made to a degree granting college. If the student should transfer to another major, then the requirements should be those in effect at the time of the transfer. For a student enrolled in an associate degree priorgram Summit college, the requirements shall be those in effect upon entrance into the program.
- (4) For purposes of meeting foreign guage requirements, all foreign languages and American Sign Languagecan fulfill the foreign language requirement for those programs that have asprecific foreign language requirement. However, for those majors or programs that specify specificand guage requirements, the applicable specific language requirement must be met to satisfy graduation requirements for that major or program.
- (5) Be approved for graduation by the appropriate college faculty, faculty senate, and board of trustees.
- (6) Complete the requirements for a degree in not more than five calendar years from the date of transfer, as defined below. In the event the student fails to complete the degree requirements within five calendar years from the date of transfer, the university reserves the right to make changes in the number of credits and/or courses required for a degree.

If a student who has transferred from another institution wishes to present for the student's major fewer than fourteen credits earned at the university of Akron written permission of both the dean and head of the department concerned is required.

The date of transfer for a student into a baccalaureate program will be the date that the student is accepted by the degreeing college. For a student enred in an associate degree progrimm Summit college, the date of transfer refers to the date of entrance into the program.

- (7) Credit hour minimums
 - (a) Earn at least one hundred twenty credits in the baccalaureate degree or sixty credits in the associat degree.
 - (a)(b) Earn the last thirty we thirty credits in the baccalaureate degree total or sixted fifteen credits in the associate degree total in residence at the university of Akron unless excused in writing by the dean of the college in which the deent is enrolled.
 - (b)(c) Earn a minimum of thirty-two thirty credits in the baccalaureate degree total or sixt didteen credits in the associate degree total in residence at the university of Akron.
- (8) Discharge of all other obligations to the university of Akron.
