(ii) If the university does not permit the ustent to enroll or continue except for disciplinary reasons. No refund will together to a student dismissed or suspended for disciplinary reasons.

- (i) All refund calculations are determined by class length percentage, not by class meetings completed or classesting percentage. Class length is defined as the number of days between and including the beginning and ending dates of any given terms in (including weekend days and holidays). The standard fifteenweek academic semester refund calculation is as follows: fall/spring/summer semester percentages which apply are:
 - (a) One hundred per centfuend through day fourtere If 6.667 per cent of class completed, one hundred per cent refund.
 - (b) Zero per cent refund after dayufrteen. If 13.333 precent of class completed, seventy per cent refund.
 - (c) If 20 per cent of class propleted, fifty per cent refund.
 - (d) If 26.667 per cent of classropleted, thirty per cent refund.
 - (e) If 33.333 per cent of classrapleted, twenty per cent refund.
 - (f) Greater than 33.333 peent of class time completed, zero per cent refund.
- (c) Refunds for course sections that aherter than the standard fifteen week academic semester which have not been scheduled consistent with either the standard fifteen week fall/spring/summer

(d) Refunds will be determined of the date of formalithdrawal unless proof is submitted that circumstances beyond control of the student, e.g., hospital confinement, prevented the filing of the ficial withdrawal earlier, in which case the refund will be determined as the date of said circumstance. The student assumes responsibility for filing for a refund.

- (e) Refunds will be mailed provided ason as possible. Refund checks Refunds are subject to deduction for any amounted to the university of Akron by the student. Depending on the total withdrawal anthe refund due, if any, a balance may still be owed on an installment payment plan contract.
- (f) No refund will be granted to a student dismissed or suspended for disciplinary reasons.
